### Acupressure points for sedating, strengthening or triple pointing meridians

\* Acupoints in bold are used when strengthening or sedating meridians other than their own. (SI2 +3 are used to fill in for HT on one occasion). Each of these points is the same element point as its meridian.

E.g. K10 is a Water point on a Water meridian. ST36 is an Earth point on an Earth meridian.
